## CANDIDATE NOMINATION OBJECTIONS AND APPEALS <br> Adjudication at district, state/region sub-commissions and UEC central. <br> 67 Appeals filed relating to rejection of candidate nomination: 56 Dismissed and 11 Reversed (nomination accepted). 3 Appeals filed at UEC central relating to ethnic candidates nomination. 21 Cases reviewed by UEC central on its own initiative: 13 Reversed (nomination accepted) and 8 Dismissed.

## MEDIATION COMMITTEES ON

## 448

 Mediation Committees meetings held across the country at village/ward tract, township, district, state/region and UEC central levels.
## POST-ELECTION OBJECTIONS/TRIBUNALS

45 Objections relating to results of elected candidate filed within 45 days period. 45 Election Tribunals established - 3 UEC Commissioners. 333 Hearings held in Naypyitaw, Shan and Kachin so far.

## ELECTION EXPENSES REPORTS

175 Candidates (and their 32 agents) failed to file reports on time. 12 Tribunals established.

159 Candidates disqualified by UEC for upcoming by-elections.
