

Which Form do I need to fill out when?

Form (3) to add your Name in the List.

If you, or a member of your family, are eligible for voting and your name is not in the list at your place of permanent residence. Or if you are a first time voter!

Form (4-C) to correct personal details

If there are errors with the spelling of your name, or with the NRC number or with other personal details.

Form (4) to make objections

If there are people on the voter list that shouldn't be included in the voter list (for eg. the deceased) and should be removed.

Form (3-A) if you have been living away from your permanent address for more than 90 days

If you have been living away from your permanent address for more than 90 days, make sure you submit Form 3-A to the ward/village tract sub-commission 30 days before the election date. It is recommended to attach a copy of your ID card, certificates for residence or other evidence.
There is no fee.



Remember that if you or your family members or friends need to insert, correct, or object a name on the voter list, you will have to submit the necessary forms to the ward/village tract sub-commission! You can only check your name online, so make sure you check on time, so you have enough time to go to the ward/village tract in case you need to make changes!

This is your last chance, make sure you go and check your name!

Election Day is on 08 November 2020, make sure you are ready to vote!

These the most important reminders:

Step 1 Stay safe!

Keep yourself and your environment safe, follow these COVID-19 safety measures:

What to do:



If you feel sick, stay home. Call a doctor for advice.



Maintain 6 feet social distance



Wear a mask when you go outside



Avoid hand shakes



Avoid touching your face.



Cover your mouth or nose with bent elbow or tissue when sneezing or coughing



Wash your hands often with soap and water



throw away tissue and wash hands

Step 2 Are you eligible to vote?

Every person who is a citizen, associate citizen, naturalized citizen or holder of temporary certificate who is at least 18 years old on the day of the election and who is included in the voter list of his or her constituency.

Step 3 Check the voter list!

For those of you that have already checked, go and check again! This is your last chance to make sure your name is on the voter list and that there are no further corrections needed!

You can also use the QR code to access the website easily! How do I do this?



- 1 Open your QR Code Reader on your phone
- 2 Hold your device over a QR Code so that it's clearly visible within your smartphone's screen
- 3 Launch the website
- 4 You must type using Pyidaungsu font not Zawgyi

If you do not find your name on the Voter List or the details are incorrect go to your ward/village tract office to fill in the required form.

Step 4 Go and vote!

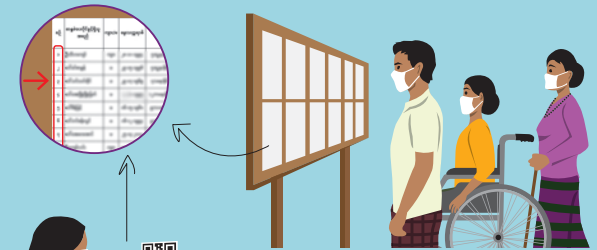
Congratulations. You are now ready to vote on 08 November 2020.



Remember!

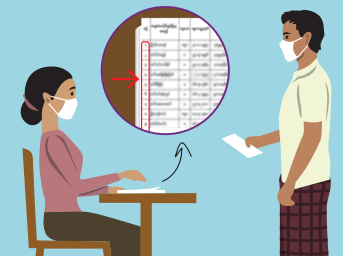
To make it easier to find your name on the voter list on election day, follow this simple advice:

- 1A During the voter list display note down your voter list serial number.
- 2 On election day, outside of the polling station, find your name with the serial number on the voter list display.



- 1B Or check your name online and note your voter list serial number.

- 3 On election day, inside the polling station, give the serial number to the polling station voter list checker to find your name easily on the voter list!



Take this chance and check your family member serial numbers as well! This will make sure that you can vote faster and you can ensure better social distancing!
